We lost our church building in the Canterbury Earthquakes; this limited us in how we could work with our community. But what was a devastating event can now be seen as an opportunity for us to build a new place and come together in our ministry to support those that need us. The Aldersgate Centre will not only be our place of worship, it will provide a heart for social support services in the central city. The complex will be flexible, welcoming and practical.

This exciting new centre will be open to all, and we want to especially provide a place of refuge and support for those at risk of being marginalised or left out. The Centre will house the Christchurch Methodist Mission Social Services and Christian World Service and it will provide a gathering place for community events and meetings and be open to people of all faiths and none.

It will serve as a base for the **stree** S Ministry, a unique exciting ministry created for the purpose of engaging with the re-emerging inner city community of Christchurch in innovative and creative ways.

To allow us to build the Aldersgate Centre we need your support. While we have 85% of the funding required we need to fundraise \$1,400,000 to complete the building and fit it out properly to serve our community. The time is now and we encourage you to give today so that we can build our Centre for the future.

Aldersgate Centre

The Aldersgate Centre has been thoughtfully designed for purpose and the building includes a worship space, a performance and conference space, community break-out spaces, offices that will be tenanted by the Methodist Mission Social Services and Christian World Service as well as full commercial kitchen amenities allowing it to support larger events. A contemplative garden space with a water feature is also included. Careful consideration to cost was taken throughout the design and tendering processes and a total project budget of \$10,750,000 has been set. This is considerably less than first estimates and we are excited the Aldersgate Centre plans provide for a fully equipped building. Future plans include re-instating a pipe organ. Construction has begun and completion is expected late 2019.

A message from the Superintendent


God gives us a future daring us to go into dreams and dangers on a path unknown...
